We require a minimum of 10 paying children per group (maximum of 125), and 1 adult per 4 children. The cost is \$3.75 per child, with the adults in the 1:4 ratio free of charge. Additional adults are \$3.75 per person.

Field trips are scheduled to last 1 hour and 30 minutes in length. We can accommodate special circumstances with advance notice.



Step-By-Step Field Trip Planning

Before Your Visit:

During Your Visit:

Mobius Kids Exhibit Areas

Geotopia

Get into your element in this gallery. Geotopia highlights the interplay of water, wind, and weather on our ecosystem. Play-to-learn about the Spokane Aquifer, our community's valuable resource. Young learners also dig for dinosaurs and plant fossils. Live insects are included in this gallery as well. Observe Stick Insects, Madagascar Hissing Cockroaches, an African Millipede, and Leggy Peggy, a Rosehair Tarantula.
